Periodontal disease (“dental disease”) is one of the most common health issues faced by pets, with up to 70% of cats and 80% of dogs showing signs of dental health issues by the time they are 3 years old. Dental disease can cause bad breath, tooth loss, severe pain, and has been linked to diseases of vital body organs including the heart and kidneys. Luckily, dental disease is preventable and treatable with a little extra routine care.

Under this promotion, routine cleaning procedures will cost \$225 and include the following: examination of your pet by a veterinarian, sedation and anesthetic induction, intubation and isoflurane maintenance anesthesia with veterinary technician monitoring, ultrasonic scaling and polishing of teeth (removes tartar and plaque above and below the gumline, just like your dentist does for you!), and products to take home to help your pet maintain a clean, healthy mouth.

Again, dental disease can be prevented with proper care and maintenance; avoid bad breath, gingivitis, pain, and tooth loss with routine dental cleanings. Please note that additional costs may be incurred if your pet has severe dental problems and/or needs any teeth extracted during its procedure.
